# SPECIAL CATEGORY DATA

Our appointment and booking service is provided by Reservio. They specialise in providing secure collection, processing and storage of personal data for healthcare practitioners.

Your data is stored through Reservio using their data storage facilities, databases and the Reservio web framework, on secure servers, always encrypted when in storage and whilst being transmitted across the Internet. When you come for your first massage we will carry out an initial consultation and with your explicit consent, we will gather personal information including your health history and any personal preferences regarding your massage, this information is held on paper securely on site at Massage Works Bristol.

## OUR COLLECTION AND USE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We collect personal information about you when you access our website, register with us, contact us, send us feedback, purchase services or gift cards.

We collect this personal information from you either directly, such as when you register with us, contact us or purchase products or services via our website or indirectly, such as your browsing activity while on our website.

The personal information we collect about you depends on the particular activities carried out through our website. Such information includes:

- your name, address and contact details
- date of birth
- bank account and payment details
- details of any feedback you give us by phone, email, post or via social media
- information about the services we provide to you

We use this personal information to:

- create and manage your account with us
- verify your identity
- provide services to you
- customise our website and its content to your particular preferences
- notify you of any changes to our website or to our services that may affect you
- improve our services

This website is not intended for use by children under the age of 16 and we do not knowingly collect or use personal information relating to children.

#### DATA RETENTION

By law, we have to keep basic information about customers (including contact identity, financial and transaction data) for six years after they cease being customers for taxation purposes.

#### TRANSFER OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may transfer your personal information to a country that is located outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

If such countries do not have the same data protection laws as the United Kingdom and EEA, any transfer of your personal information will be subject to a suitable relevant safeguard eg European Commission approved contract. If you would like further information please contact us. We will not otherwise transfer your personal data outside of the United Kingdom or to any organisation (or subordinate bodies) governed by public international law or which is set up under any agreement between two or more countries.

### OUR LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

When we use your personal information we are required to have a legal basis for doing so. There are various different legal bases upon which we may rely, depending on what personal information we process and why.

The legal bases we may rely on include:

- **consent:** where you have given us clear consent for us to process your personal information for a specific purpose
- **contract:** where our use of your personal information is necessary for a contract we have with you, or because you have asked us to take specific steps before entering into a contract for services
- **legal obligation:** where our use of your personal information is necessary for us to comply with the law (not including contractual obligations)
- **vital interests:** where our use of your personal information is necessary to protect you or someone else's life
- **legitimate interests:** where our use of your personal information is necessary for our legitimate interests or the legitimate interests of a third party (unless there is a good reason to protect your personal information which overrides our legitimate interests).

## INFORMATION YOU PROVIDE

Where we need to collect any personal data by law, or under the terms of an agreement we have with you, and you fail to provide that data when requested, we may not be able to perform the agreement we have or are trying to enter into with you.

## YOUR RIGHTS

Under the General Data Protection Regulation and Data Protection Act 2018 you have a number of important rights free of charge. In summary, those include rights to:

- fair processing of information and transparency over how we use your use personal information
- access to your personal information and to certain other supplementary information that this privacy policy is already designed to address
- require us to correct any mistakes in your information which we hold
- require the erasure of personal information concerning you in certain situations
- receive the personal information concerning you which you have provided to us, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to a third party in certain situations
- object at any time to processing of personal information concerning you for direct marketing
- object to decisions being taken by automated means which produce legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affect you
- object in certain other situations to our continued processing of your personal information
- otherwise restrict our processing of your personal information in certain circumstances

If you would like to exercise any of those rights, please:

- let us know the information to which your request relates.

#### SECURITY

We have appropriate security measures in place to prevent personal information from being accidentally lost, or used or accessed in an unauthorised way. We limit access to your personal information to those who have a genuine business need to know it. Those processing your information will do so only in an authorised manner and are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so.

# COMPLAINTS

We hope that we can resolve any query or concern you raise about our use of your information.

The General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018 also gives you a right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the European Union (or European Economic Area) state where you work, normally live or where any alleged infringement of data protection laws occurred.
